

# Score forms

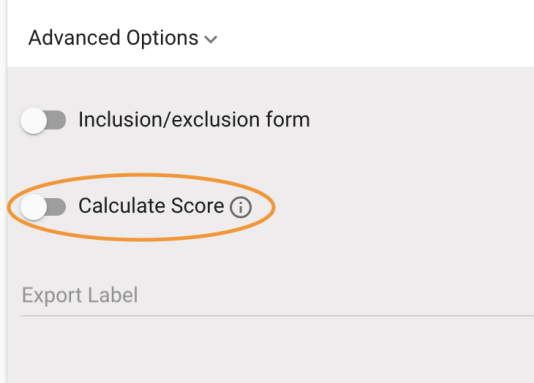
A score form is a special type of form in SMART-TRIAL. This type of form calculates a total score for the form, based upon the answers given. The total score is calculated by **summing** up the values for all "included questions". This allows users to create questionnaires with rather complex calculations.

Score forms are limited to the following question types:

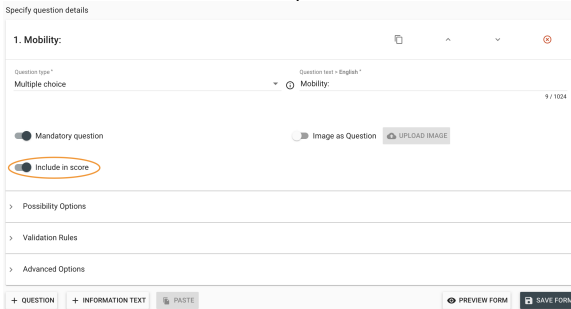

## To create a score form:

1. Go to **[Study Name] > Forms**, or **[Study Name] > Study Info**.
2. Click **+ New Form**.
3. Enter the **name of the form** and click **Advanced Options**, then enable **calculate score**.



4. Click **Add Question**. A part where you can specify the question details will appear.
5. Select **Question Type** and specify the **Question text**.
6. Enable, **include in score** for all questions which should be included in the total score.



7. Click **Save Form**.

For 5 level smiley, Multiple choice/Multiple response, and Yes/No question types, the user must set the 'value' of each possibility, see image below for an example. Here possibility A will add a value of 12 to the total score



By using [Calculated Questions](#) it is possible to do more advanced calculations than sums, based upon the input of previous questions.
